



Some interesting facts:

- There are nine (9) school districts in Section III alone, equal in size or smaller than Fabius-Pompey, that have both a Boys Varsity Football and a Boys Varsity Soccer program – Dolgeville, Mohawk, Oriskany, Alexandria, IHC, Morrisville, Hamilton, Frankfurt-Schuyler, West Canada Valley
- Fabius-Pompey is a Class D School - Statewide there are 77 Class D Schools that have Boys Varsity Football
- In Section III, Fabius-Pompey is the largest school to only have Boys Varsity Soccer and no football – it is 25% larger than the next largest school to offer only soccer (Fabius-Pompey 232, Poland 188)
- Based on the current enrollment at Fabius-Pompey, only 1 out of 6 eligible boys would need to play football to meet the minimum roster requirements ( 1 out of 5 or greater is desired)
- Without any outside support, the cost to the average homeowner to operate both a Modified Boys (grades 7-9) and a Varsity Boys (grades 10-12) Football program would be around \$15 per year. The Foundation was established to help offset this cost.
- Football provides opportunities for students other than just the athletes – the Cheerleaders, the Marching Band, and the Color Guard to perform during the game and at a halftime; the Chorus to perform the National Anthem at the start of each game; the Dance club to perform at halftime; and the audio visual students to record and photograph the games.
